

Croatia Solar Panel Scheme

The measure, which has a total budget of approximately €783 million (HRK 6 billion), will be open until 2023. The aid will be paid out to the selected beneficiaries for a period of 12 years. The scheme will help Croatia increase its share of electricity produced from renewable energy sources and reduce CO2 and other greenhouse gas emissions.

Will Croatia support electricity production from renewable sources?

The European Commission has approved, under EU State aid rules, a Croatian aid scheme to support electricity production from renewable sources.

How much electricity is produced in Croatia?

According to the Energy Report for 2016, the electricity produced from RES amounted to 46.7% of the gross electricity consumption in Croatia. Out of that, the electricity produced in large hydro power plants amounted to 37.8%, whereas electricity produced from other renewable sources amounted to 8.9%.

When will the renewables Act be implemented in Croatia?

In December 2018 the Croatian Parliament adopted the amendments to the Renewables Act and the Government adopted two implementing regulations, which jointly apply as of 1 January 2019 (" 2019 Amendments").

Are imported coal and oil filling the energy gap in Croatia?

Imported coal, oil and gas are filling the gap. "In Croatia, we have exhausted all of our hydropower resources," said Andro Bacan, a renewable energy expert at the state-owned Energy Institute Hrvoje Pozar back in the busy capital Zagreb.


