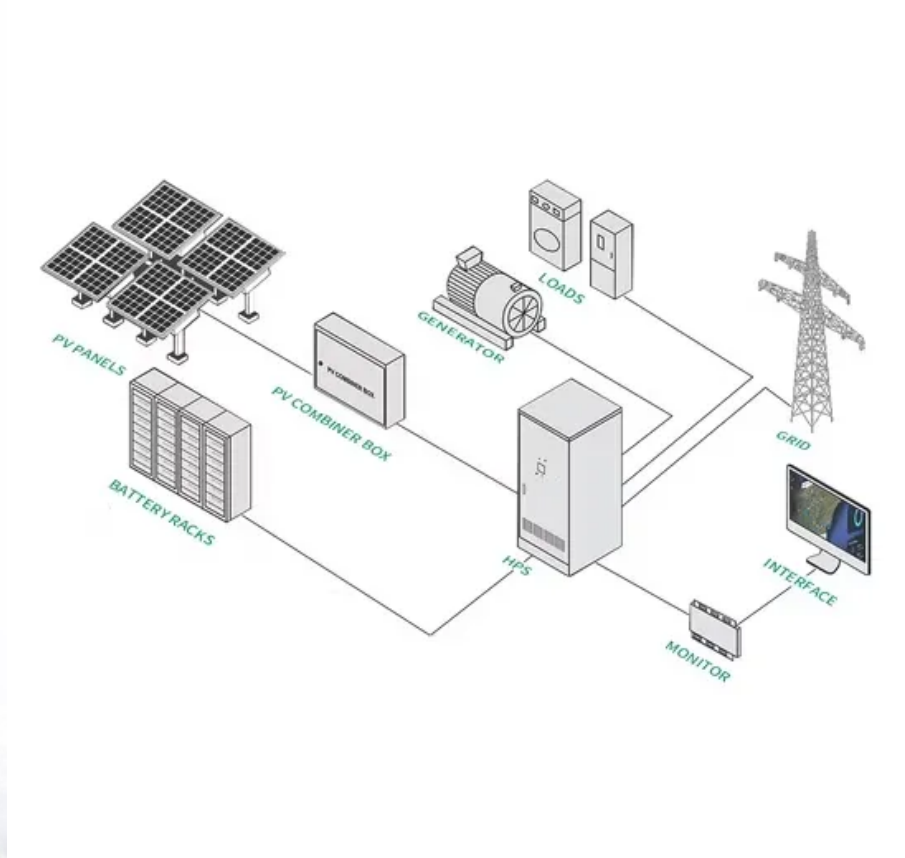

Overview

Does El Salvador have a public school system?

El Salvador has both a private and public school system. The public school system is free and anyone can enroll (according to article 59 of the Education General Law); and, the cost of a private education varies depending on the school. Both private and public schools either run on the (1) national system, OR the (2) international system.

What is the education system like in El Salvador?

In rural areas, the situation is way worse than in urban areas, so the country as a whole faces tons of challenges. Kindergarten is the first step in the education of El Salvador, and it is optional. Education becomes mandatory in primary school at age 7, followed by 9 years of schooling.

How long is education in El Salvador?

Afterward, there are five years of college education at universities or other tertiary institutions. In El Salvador, education is usually free until children reach the ninth grade at 14 to 15 years old. However, only about 82% of Salvadoran students make it this far.

Is education free in El Salvador?

Although not completely free (parents who can afford to pay do so) education is a high priority in El Salvador where so many poor families are still fighting to escape poverty. To make their lot worse, standards in rural areas are low compared to cities. Following optional kindergarten children enroll in primary school at age 7.

When does education become mandatory in El Salvador?

Education becomes mandatory in primary school at age 7, followed by 9 years of schooling. These 9 years are divided into 3 cycles of 3 years, with the last one being a transition to middle school. Secondary school in El Salvador is



basically the last cycle of three years of primary school.

Who provides vocational training in El Salvador?

Vocational training is provided by private colleges. This is overseen by the Salvadorian Vocational Training Institute. It aims to grow the country's knowledge base while improving the living standards of workers and their families. There are 23 universities in El Salvador. of which some are secular and some have religious affiliations.

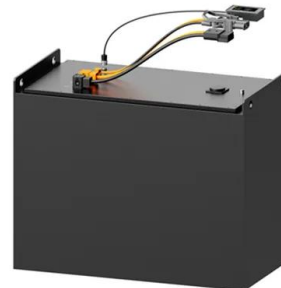

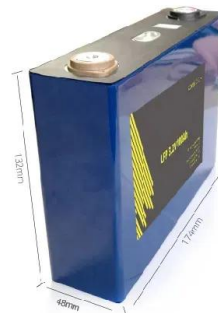
