The Marshall Islands National Telecommunications Authority is a private corporation with significant ownership by the National Government and the authorized sole provider of telecommunications services. The Marshall Islands National Telecommunications Authority (NTA) is deploying a turnkey LTE & WiFi solution from U.S.-based technology providers Alepo and Blue Arcus to rapidly evolve the country's mobile broadband infrastructure from 2G to 4G.

Where are the Marshall Islands located?

The Marshall Islands is an island country in Oceania. In 2010, the Majuro and Kwajalein Atoll were connected to the HANTRU-1 undersea communications cable to provide high-speed bandwidth. Faster internet service was rolled out to Majuro and Ebeye on April 1, 2010.

What is the top level domain of the Marshall Islands?

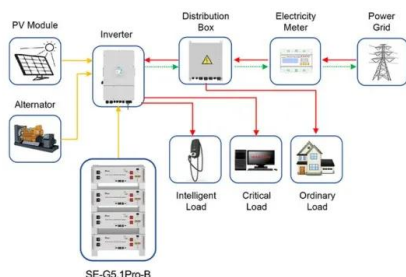
