Overview

What is the PERC rule?

Differentiates between patients at low or high risk of pulmonary embolism. In the text below the calculator there is more information on the rule and on the original study. The PERC rule reveals patients who are at low risk of pulmonary embolism in an accurate and rapid manner so differential diagnosis can be initiated.

What is the sensitivity and specificity of the PERC rule?

Note: Low-risk patients (clinical suspicion for PE and met the PERC rule criteria) had a prevalence of PE of 1.4% (95% CI, 0.5 - 3.0%). Application of the PERC rule to patients at "very-low risk" resulted in a sensitivity of 100% and specificity of 15%.

What is the NPV of the PERC rule?

The PERC rule achieved an NPV of 73.2% (95% CI 26.0 - 95.5%) for diagnosis of PE, with an area under the ROC curve of 0.520 (95% CI 0.388-0.653) (Figure 2). PE is a common entity that has a significant impact on patient morbidity, mortality, and prognosis.

Does the PERC rule exclude a gestalt pretest probability of 15%?

To capture that concept scientifically, I validated the PERC rule to exclude PE with a gestalt pretest probability of <15% for PE and all eight criteria of the PERC rule are negative. Jeffrey Kline, MD, is a professor of emergency medicine and physiology and the vice chair of research at Indiana University.

Does age-adjusted D-dimer and PERC rule reduce the use of CTPA?

The PERC rule would have reduced use by 7%, with an AUC of 0.72. Application of age-adjusted D-dimer and the PERC rule to patients taken for CTPA because of suspected PE seems to reduce the number of indications for the procedure. Keywords: pulmonary embolism, fibrin degradation product,

What is the perc test sensitivity?



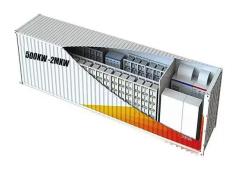
