


# Tuvalu 2025 Solar Photovoltaic Panel Project







## **Overview**

What is the Tuvalu solar power project?

The Government of Tuvalu worked with the e8 group to develop the Tuvalu Solar Power Project, which is a 40 kW grid-connected solar system that is intended to provide about 5% of Funafuti 's peak demand, and 3% of the Tuvalu Electricity Corporation's annual household consumption.

What was the first large scale solar system in Tuvalu?

The first large scale system in Tuvalu was a 40 kW solar panel installation on the roof of Tuvalu Sports Ground. This grid-connected 40 kW solar system was established in 2008 by the E8 and Japan Government through Kansai Electric Company (Japan) and contributes 1% of electricity production on Funafuti.

Is Tuvalu A good place to invest in wind power?

Beyond the solar farm, Tuvalu is also exploring wind energy opportunities. Preliminary assessments on several outer islands are underway to determine the feasibility of wind power. These efforts are part of a broader strategy to diversify Tuvalu's renewable energy sources, ensuring a stable and reliable electricity supply.

What is Tuvalu's energy policy?

Tuvalu commits to reduction of emissions of green-house gases from the electricity generation (power) sector, by 100%, ie almost zero emissions by 2025. Tuvalu's indicative quantified economy-wide target for a reduction in total emissions of GHGs from the entire energy sector to 60% below 2010 levels by 2025.
